You'll work closely with our existing Chair, sharing responsibilities according to your respective strengths, availability and the needs of the charity. The role also provides an opportunity for longer-term succession planning, with the potential to become Chair in the future.

In return, you'll have the opportunity to develop your leadership and governance experience in a meaningful setting, work alongside an experienced Chair and see the impact of the Board's decisions as Share delivers its new strategy and grows.

We're looking for someone who is:

- An experienced charity trustee with a good understanding of governance.
- A thoughtful and collaborative leader who brings people with them.
- Comfortable facilitating discussion and drawing out different perspectives.

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- Confident challenging assumptions without needing to win the argument.
- A good listener who can make sense of different views and help a group reach a decision.
- Warm, approachable and able to create a positive and enjoyable Board environment.

The practical bit

The Board meets in person four times a year, plus the AGM (an hour). The Vice-Chair will also need to make additional time for preparation, conversations with the Chair, Board matters between meetings and the responsibilities shared between the two Chairs.

You'll receive a full induction and relevant training, and you'll work closely with the existing Chair and Board.
